This document explains how to register with the DFL SSO, apply for an account and log in to the portals that are activated per user.

Onboarding for the DFL-SSO

In the event that you have been provided with a login by the DFL (or one of its subsidiaries), you will usually receive an onboarding email from the sender "noreply@access.bundesliga.com" with the subject "Welcome to the DFL Single Sign-On".

This onboarding email lists the portals for which you have been given access, the request to enter a password for this account and the link to the DFL Single Sign-On.In the event that your account was created as part of a portal change (e.g. the Commentary Live System), you will not receive this onboarding email but will be informed of the changed login by your respective contact person.

In this case, you must also log in to the DFL SSO for the first time using the e-mail address you used to log in to the respective portal. The most important steps are described below.

If you have received an onboarding email, please start directly with the assignment of the new password for the DFL Single Sign-On. To do this, please follow the instructions below:

- 1. Click on the link in the email
- 2. You will be redirected to the DFL Single Sign-On and the following interface will open up

Continuation – Account activation with password link

After you have entered the code, you will receive a confirmation that your account has been verified. Please click on "Continue".

You will now be asked to set a new password. The password must be at least 12 characters long, contain both lower and upper case letters, numbers and special characters.

You will now be taken back to the home page where you can enter your email address and new password. When logging in for the first time, you will be asked to confirm the data protection agreement. After confirmation, you will now see the portals available in the DFL SSO. You can recognise the portals that have been activated for you by the fact that they are not "greyed out" (e.g. Bundesliga Photo Database).By clicking on a portal tile, you can jump directly to the respective portal and continue your activities as usual.

Account activation without onboarding email
